Welcome to the Network's 2022 Annual Awards Gala. Thank you so much for joining us this evening. After a two-year virtual hiatus, we are thrilled to re-convene in-person and excited to lead this fantastic organization into the next chapter. The past two years have brought our community even closer and tonight we celebrate our strength and communal achievements, as well as the Network's new leadership and two outstanding tenants.

Over the past few years, our work has become even more pressing. COVID-19 exacerbated our already dire homeless and affordable housing crisis and proved even further that housing equals healthcare. Amidst it all, this community hasn't skipped a beat, and has continued

developing the pipeline of new, quality supportive housing.

The Network's advocacy this past year secured a commitment to the next five years and 7,000 units of the Empire State Supportive Housing Initiative (ESSHI), and led to a new commitment to preserve 3,000 units of existing supportive housing. In New York City, the Network has worked closely with membership and government partners to streamline the process for filling units. Statewide, we supported members with issues large and small to keep projects moving forward, building and sustaining community among our membership and convening government partners and other stakeholders with members around emerging issues.

Tonight, the Network is thrilled to celebrate and welcome our new Executive Director, Pascale Leone. Pascale is a leader in the supportive housing movement. As a passionate advocate and equity practitioner, Pascale has worked for close to two decades on a wide range of

issues related to improving the lives of underserved and at-risk individuals with a focus on achieving impactful and equitable outcomes.

The residents of supportive housing are the reason we do what we do. Tonight, we are delighted to honor two Outstanding Tenants of the Year: Cynthia Hairston and Maliq Edwards. Cynthia Hairston is a passionate member of her supportive housing community, who has helped fellow tenants to get vaccinated and supported them around substance misuse at Lantern Community Services' Clover Hall residence. Maliq Edwards, a tenant at Housing Works' StandUp Harlem, has, during this past year, truly utilized the strength of his relationships with supportive housing staff to stabilize, pursue a degree in criminal justice, and bring his passionate voice to the organization to interview new staff.

We're grateful for the work all of you do to further this

movement and we're honored to have you here tonight—as friends, colleagues, and advocates—in recognition of our accomplishments and in support of our shared goal of ending homelessness in New York.

Outstanding Tenant of the Year Cynthia Hairston



Named 'the mayor' by fellow tenants and staff at Lantern Community Services' Clover Hall, Cynthia Hairston is known for her care, support and passion for her fellow tenants and community.

"When I think about Cynthia, what comes to mind is her kindness. She has been my backbone," said Cynthia's sister, Patricia Pennix.

Struggles with substances at a young age, incarceration and health complications led Cynthia on a journey to recovery prior to moving into Clover Hall in 2008. Despite a rocky start and a relapse, Cynthia made a commitment to stop using and sought out help from staff.

Now, 14 years later, Cynthia has maintained her recovery and become an integral member of her community. She works hard to support her peers that are still using, utilizing a non-judgmental harm reduction approach. She has said that helping others, especially during hard times, provides her with a sense of true purpose and fulfillment.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, Cynthia found a new way to support her community. Starting in 2021,

Cynthia became Clover Hall's Vaccine Ambassador during the pandemic, helping her peers make the best choices to stay healthy. She also became a member of the On-Point Advisory Board which looks at how to best support tenants and their wellness. As Vaccine Ambassador, Cynthia has helped move Clover Hall's vaccination rate from approximately 40% to nearly 90% in less than a year. She was able to accomplish this through her deep connections with her peers and having consistent and patient conversations that include supportive education, and the space to explore options for how each person can choose to stay safe.

Cultivating relationships with fellow tenants and serving as their support system is a quality of Cynthia's that many at Clover Hall admire. "She was proactive with everybody, knocking on everybody's door, every tenant. She makes sure everybody signs up for vaccines and booster shots," said fellow tenant Lamar Wooden.

"What strikes me most in working with Cynthia is her genuineness, her open-mindedness, and her willingness to advocate for herself and for others with deep integrity." Said Director of Behavioral Health at Clover Hall, Irene Walcott.

Says Cynthia: "I'm a very motivated person. When I came here, I got involved in all the projects that they have." She says she wants to live at Clover Hall for the rest of her life.

For her compassion, advocacy and continued growth we are delighted to honor Cynthia as one of our *Tenants of the Year*.

Outstanding Tenant of the Year Maliq Edwards



At Housing Works' StandUp Harlem, Maliq Edwards showcases his resiliency and determination for personal growth and does so with a joyous spirit that is admired by both staff and fellow tenants. Maliq's transformation has inspired other StandUp Harlem tenants to see what making full-use of the staff support and supportive housing services can do.

"I was really, really impressed with how much work Maliq put into pulling himself out of a destructive cycle that he was in," said StandUp Harlem's Housing Director, Philip Stone. "Now, he is back to a place that I wasn't sure we were going to see again. He is engaged in programming, addressing his substance-use issues and is back in school. He has brought back this kind of infectious, joyous spirit that we had been missing, that was kind of a cornerstone of this small StandUp Harlem community."

Struggles with substance use, an HIV diagnosis, and interaction with the criminal legal system brought Maliq to the front door of Housing Works' StandUp Harlem in 2014. Maliq admits to being closed off initially to the help offered at the residence, but

he turned a corner this past year. He recounts how José Ramirez, Program Coordinator at Housing Works gave him words of encouragement and pushed him to make a change in his life after hitting rock bottom. Says Maliq simply: "Life is much better now that I'm accepting help."

Now, committed to his health and personal-growth, Maliq has been diligent about maintaining his recovery and is in school studying criminal justice. He says he wants to bring his experience with the system to give hope to those incarcerated and let them know somebody is on their side and fighting for justice.

Housing Works staff also recognized Maliq's passionate voice and have brought him into the process of hiring new staff. He actively participates in job interviews for different positions within the Housing Works agency.

Program Coordinator José is a huge supporter: "He's this gentle giant with a big personality who actually cares for others. He cares about the staff, he cares about his neighbors, he cares about *people*."

Says Maliq about his home: "I can't wait to come back into this little world of mine. I cannot wait to open that door and come in here because this is me."

For his dedication to recovery, health and giving back to his community, we are proud to award Maliq as a *Tenant of the Year*.

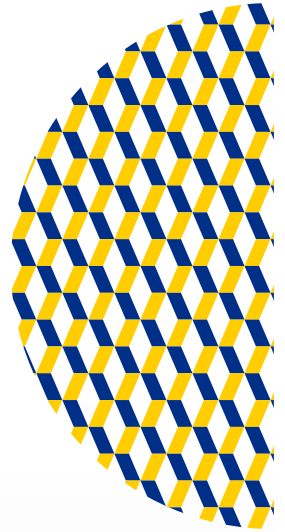

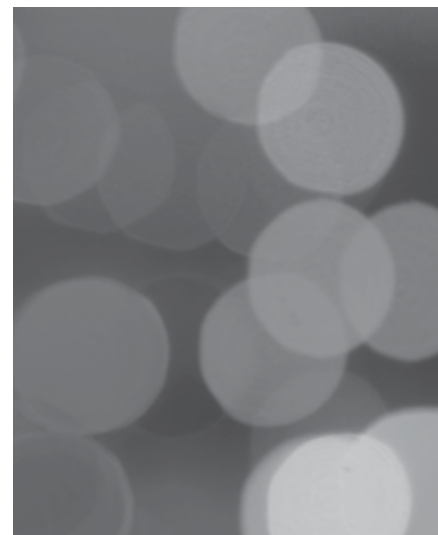

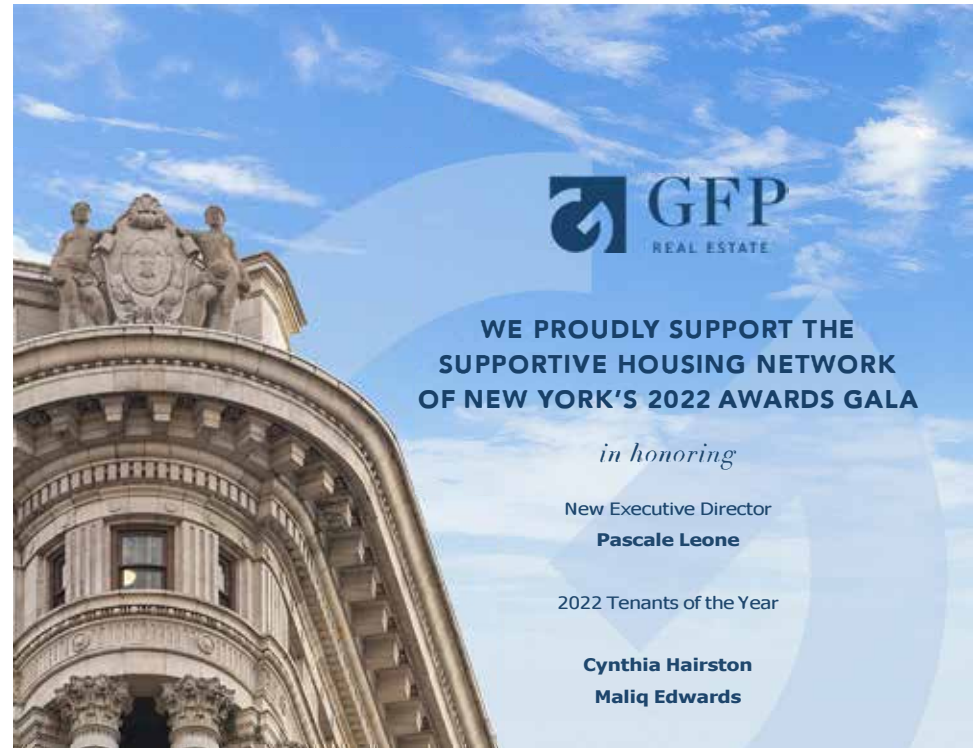
